#### **Outreach will be our final team preaching on Sunday,**

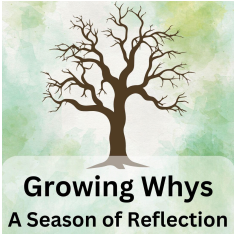

fill my cup, fill it up and make me whole!

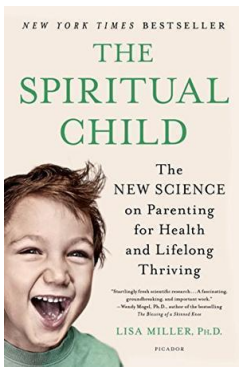
There are millions in this world who are craving

fill my cup, fill it up and make me whole!

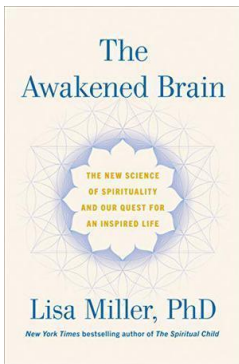




## Summer Reading Groups: The Spiritual Child & The Awakened Brain

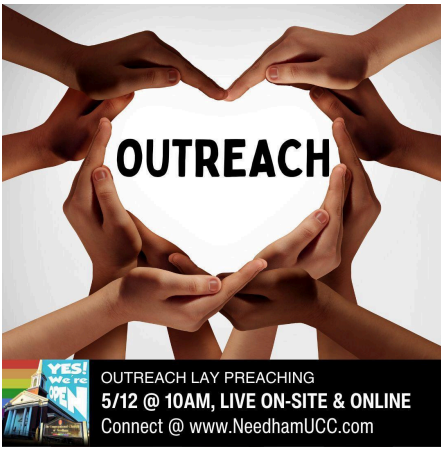
